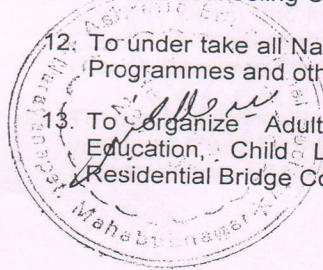

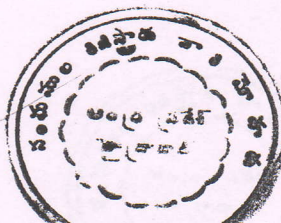

ADDED AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

1. The Ashrafia Educational Society is running School / Name Darul-Uloom-Ashrafia at Kollampally.
2. To establish Mobile Dispensaries and Hospitals for Tribal People, Schedule Cast Peoples and other weaker Section people.
3. To run rural emergency health transport system.
4. To under take all the Health needs of the poor people through Health service and Health education Programmes etc. like Free Health Checkup camps, Health Centres, Family planning and AIDS awareness programmes, Counseling Centres etc.
5. To establish and manage Girls Hostiles, Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV), Short Stay Homes for Women and Girls in distress.
6. To Construction of Hostel Building for Working Women with Day Care Centres for women and children.
7. To establish and manage SWADHAR Centres, Help Line Centres etc.
8. To start support to training and employment Programme (STEP).
9. Setting up employment and income generating training cum production units for women and all other women activities under NORAD Scheme.
10. To Establish and manage Jana Shikshan Sansthan (JSS).
11. To run Counseling Centres.
12. To under take all Natural Resource Management Programmes and other schemes of CAPART.
13. To organize Adult Education, Non Formal Education, Child Labour Camps / Hostels, Residential Bridge Course.



14. Centres, Non-residential Bridge course centers for child labour, drop out children and never enrolled children, etc and all other child development programs.
15. To undertake community infrastructures like Tanks, Canals, Check Dams and other Irrigation Works, Digging of Wells, Buildings, Roads, Bala Mandirs, Mahila Sadans, Youth Clubs, Hospitals, Youga Centres, Schools, Libraries, Teachers Quarters, Community Halls. Houses for weaker and Economically Backward Sections and SC/ST Peoples.
16. To construct model villages organize Model Agriculture Farms. Joint-farming Societies, Cross Breeding Farms, Nurseries and help the poor farmers to popularize innovations and technology transfers fro adoption by common man.
17. To take up joint forest management.
18. To undertake studies, research project and publications of literature, reports on problems relating to the objects/ activities.
19. To establish agro-service centers and agricultural training centers and organize short-term courses for agriculturists and agricultural laborers.
20. To establish Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVK) appropriate rural technology centers and production -cum-training centers in order to provide training and to disseminate latest agricultural practices to farming community and farm laborers and organize diploma or degree courses in agricultural related activates for youth.
21. To develop and implement community based low-cost comprehensive health care programmes for mothers, children and disabled persons and to organize special/ general medical camps, and disabled awareness camps.
22. To train health and development workers, special educators and social workers drawn from the governmental and non-government sectors.
23. To organize Sishu Vihars, Bala Sanghams (children clubs) and Mahila Manadals and Youth Clubs and conducting training in Leadership and Human Resource Development.
24. To conduct educational tours for the children, youth, men and women of Indian origin with the country as well as abroad.

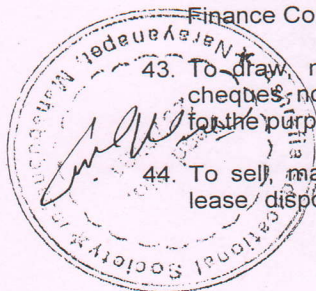


25. To co-ordinate with N.S.S, N.C.C., and other similar organizations who are working for the development and welfare of the youths.
26. To organize women into effective self help groups (SHGs), DWACRA groups, who will initiate group action programmes for women and child welfare, economic development by undertaking income generating activities and to borrow, Donations or get assistance from the Government organizations, financial institutions, Rashtriya Mahila Kosh, National Minorities Development Finance Corporation Ltd., organizations to promote this activity.
27. To increase income level of poor families by organize women into effective groups and to enhance their capabilities by upgrading their skills and to act as catalyst with backward and forward linkages.
28. To disseminate information on diet and nutrition, and to promote nutrition education in schools through mass media, publishing journals, pamphlets and other media.
29. To investigate means to offset existing deficiencies in the pattern of production and distribution of food and to ensure the wholesomeness and nutritive value of food sold for public consumption and to establish nutrition rehabilitation centers for those who are suffering with nutritive deficiencies.
30. Highlight and focus the importance of national integration by organizing youth camps, national integration camps, seminars, workshops, conferences, meetings, theme camps, debates and discussions.
31. To undertake and organize, study courses, lectures, meetings, conferences, seminars, discussions, exhibitions and the like to promote the objectives of.
32. To run all categories schools, secondary, higher and technical educational institutions, colleges of all categories for the benefit of the people.
33. To assist organize and undertake the disaster management programmes relief, rehabilitation and reconstruction activities for the people, who are affected by natural calamities like floods, cyclones, droughts, and earth quakes anywhere in India.
34. To organize homes for the old aged and physically handicapped mentally retarded, deaf and dumb and other disabled leprosy affected



persons through integrated community based and homes based intervention programmes.

35. To conduct surveys on disabled persons, physically handicapped, mentally handicapped and street children and to provide them day care centers, residential homes and to institute a SAHAYA village with an integrated services for the benefit of these sections and the street children.
36. To establish homes/Hostels and provide other integrated services for the children in need of care i.e. street children, child laborers, Rag pickers etc., and to make them useful citizens.
37. To act as a link between the central and state governments and other appropriate agencies for formulation and execution of projects, programmes and schemes for integrated rural development and to accept necessary grants or funds for fulfilling these activities.
38. To setup cottage, small scale industries and viable medium industries for the benefit of rural masses on no loss and no profit basis.
39. To raise funds (in cash or in kind), subscriptions, property of any kind from the people, institutions, organizations and agencies.
40. To acquire by gift, purchase exchange, lease or hire or otherwise howsoever any lands, buildings, easements, and any other property immovable for nay estate or interest for furtherance of all or nay objectives.
41. To accept donations and assistance for the group on behalf of the implementing agencies from the government and foreign donors and to furnish information regarding the physical and financial progress of the schemes/ programmes to the concerned organizations.
42. To borrow and raise funds with or without security in any manner as the society may think fit and to repay the same, either from individuals, financial institution / any Banks (Like NABARD, SIDBI, other commercial banks) or government departments / organizations like Rashtriya Mahila Kosh, National Minority Development Finance Corporation National Handicapped Finance Corporation etc. and other agencies.
43. To draw, make accept, endorse and discount cheques, notes or other negotiable instruments for the purpose of activities.
44. To sell, manage, transfer, exchange mortgage, lease dispose off or otherwise deal with any

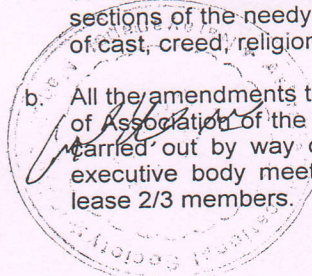


property whatsoever belonging to in the interest of the organization and people.

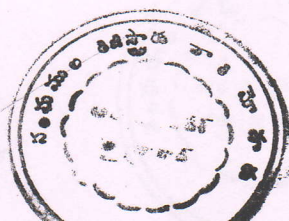
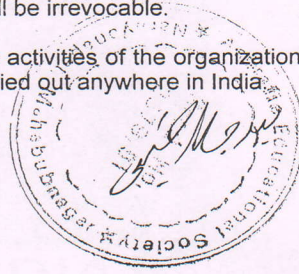
45. To maintain accounts of all receipts and expenditures of and correctness of accounts and balance sheet which a chartered accountant shall audit at least once in a year.
46. To help and assist habitat development and promotion including slum clearance and house construction for economically weaker sections, downtrodden in the urban and rural areas with the beneficiary participation.
47. To encourage art and cultural activities through, dramas, dances and literacy conferences and to assist the organization in construction on open-air theaters in rural and urban slums.
48. To propagate the prohibition ideology through de-addiction campaigns, workshops, seminars, including cultural activities.
49. To work for the integrated development of the minority communities SC/ST and Backward communities in country.
50. To do all such other lawful acts, deeds or things, either alone or in conjunction with other organizations as are incidental or conducive to attainment the objectives of.
51. To deposit the funds of not immediately required in deposit with nationalized bank or in any securities authorized under the investment of the funds of the organization shall be in accordance with the provision of (section 13(i) (d)) read with section 11 (5) of the income tax act 1961.
52. To distribute the assets of the society in the event of dissolution / Winding up to the society with similar activates that are registered under the society registration act 2001. Which is also registered with income tax act under 12A and 80G.

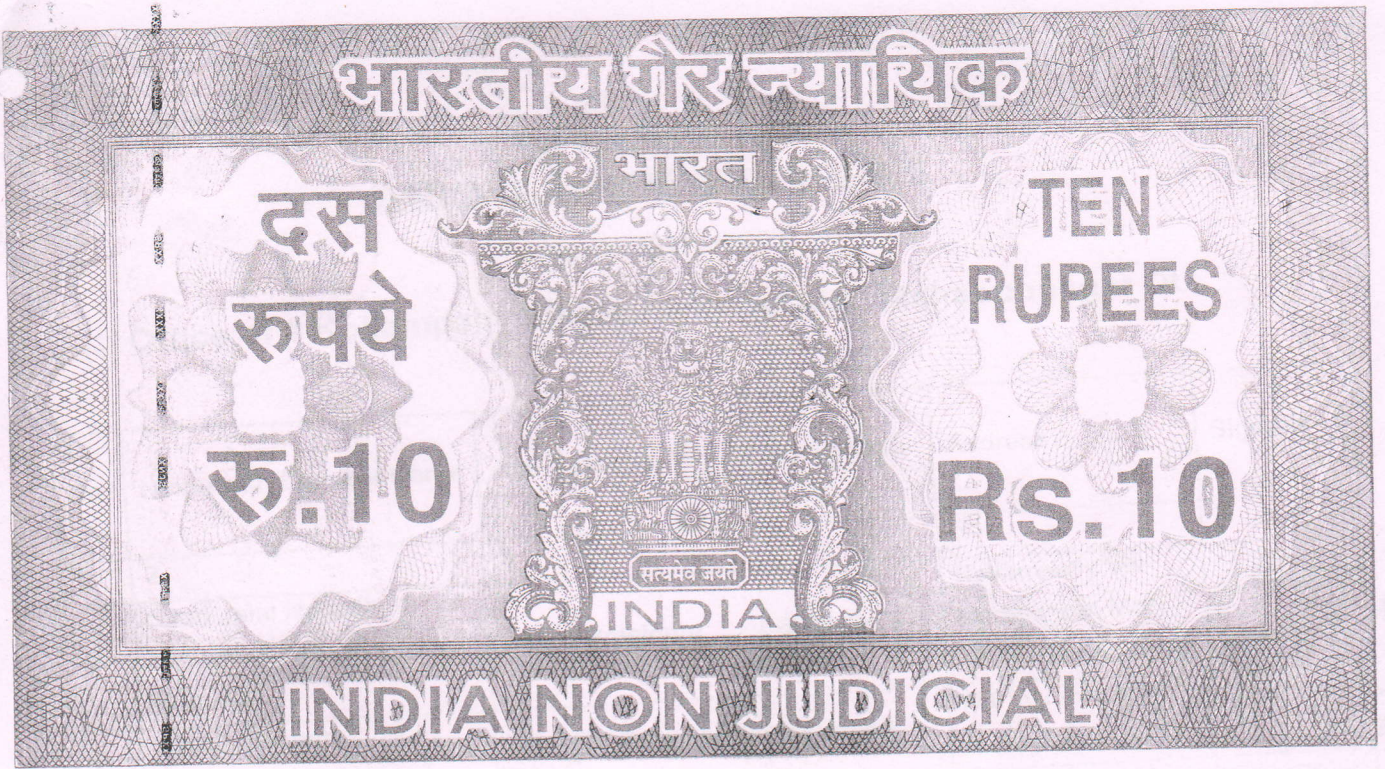
STATUS OF THE SOCIETY:

- a. The Society shall function as a non-secular, non-political one and the benefits of the society are open to all sections of the-needly people irrespective of cast, creed, religion and sex.
- b. All the amendments to the memorandum of Association of the organization will be carried out by way of resolution in the executive body meeting attended by at lease 2/3 members.



- c. All the Amendments to the memorandum of association of the Organization will be carried out only with the prior approval of the commissioner of income tax.
- d. The income of the funds of the society will be solely utilized towards the objectives and no portion of it will be used for as payments to the trustees or members by way of profits or in any other manner.
- e. The society formed under the above title shall be irrevocable.
- f. The activities of the organization shall be carried out anywhere in India.
